Results

- 👁️ draft-lear-newtrk-decruft-experiment-01.txt
- 👁️ Discusses procedure
 - 👁️ Start with $PS < 2000$
 - 👁️ Email the list to get something removed
- 👁️ Started with 125 documents

Results

- 56 Documents Remain
 - (probably 2 will fall off due to IESG actions)
- Generally three groups of docs:
 - Obsolete multiprotocol functions
 - Protocols defined but not used
 - "Dangerous" specifications

Stuff that we're leaving alone

- 👁 Specifications known to be in full use (should be considered for advancement)
- 👁 Specifications currently under review
- 👁 Specifications previously considered and rejected by the IESG
