IRTF Role & Scope:

The IRTF serves as the research counterpart to the IETF.
Organized under the auspices of the IAB.

Goals are to: (1) foster Internet-related research, and
(2) develop preliminary technology needed for IETF
efforts (includes responding to IETF needs).

IRTF Role & Scope, con't:

Currently, 13 RGs.

Generally long-lived, usually without specific deliverables.

Most operate open, some closed.

Closed ones maintain an open, public mailing list.
