Future of IPv6 Working Group

- IPv6 work no longer a focus of one WG
 - IETF-wide IPv6 considerations
- No “big ticket” items left on charter
- Propose that Vancouver be our last face-to-face meeting
- Mailing list will still be active and a place for general IPv6 discussion
- WG effort needed to shepherd current documents through to publication
