- Draft v03 published as an intermediate step
- Draft v04 not finished for IETF-71
- Advancing the draft fostered
 - Intense discussion among authors and led to new insights
 - Strong changes of existing drafts
- Understanding RFC 4774 in more detail
 - How important is leakage due to misconfiguration?
 - Fairness between ECN and PCN?
 - Coexistence of ECN and PCN possible?
- Result of discussions: existing encoding options removed by new constraints

Open Issues

- 1. Detailed description of remaining encoding options
- 2. Give reasons why major encoding options do not work
 - E.g. RFC 4774
 - Tunneling constraints in RFC 3168
 - ...
- 3. General cleanup of the draft
