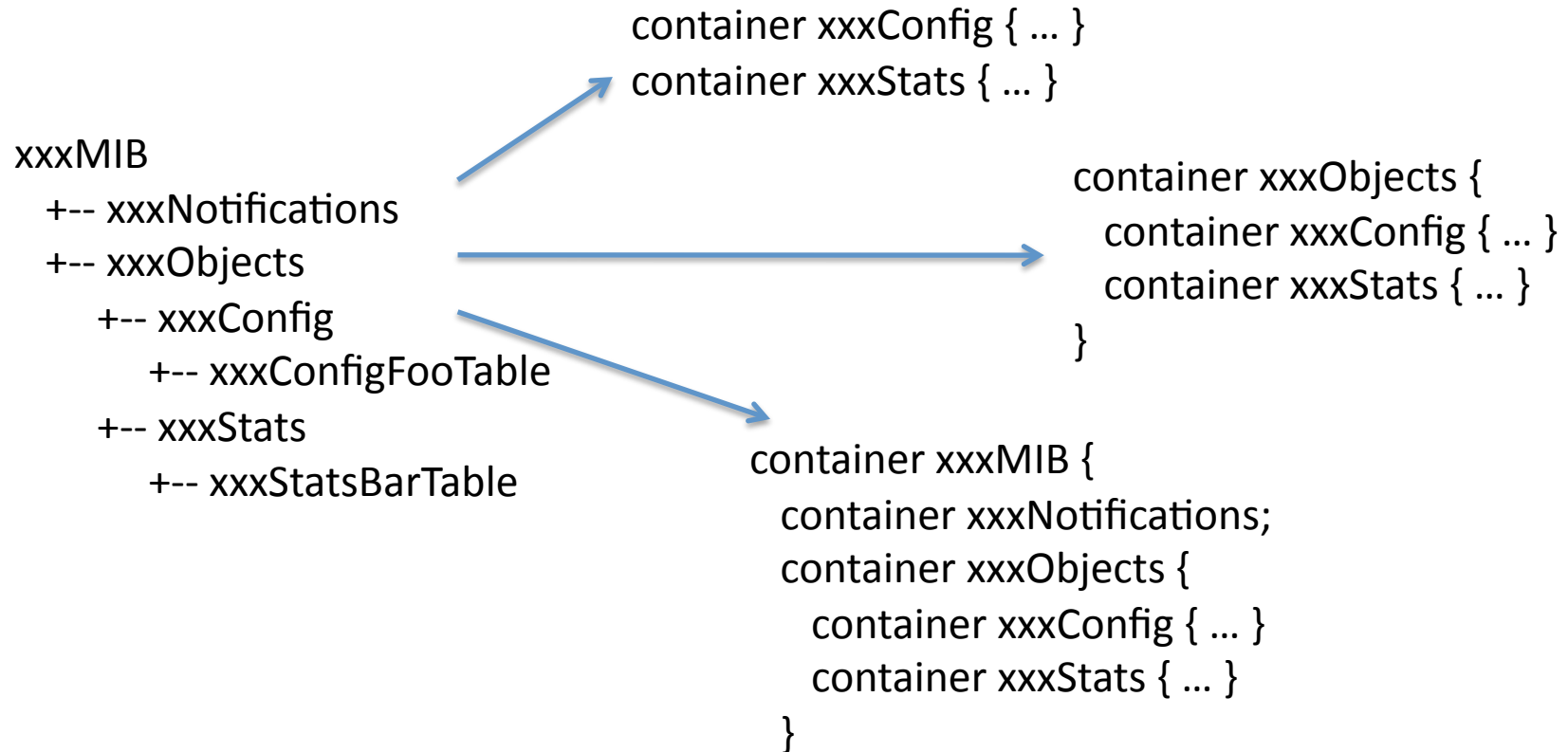

 - Revised the overall document structure, added a YANG module for the definition of YANG extensions (smiv2:oid, smiv2:display-hint, smiv2:max-access, smiv2:defval), moved the IF-MIB example into an appendix.
