 Generating certificates/ROAs/...has different security constraints than running a publication service. The former requires private keys, the latter does not.

 Generating certificates/ROAs/...has different availability constraints than running a publication service. The former only needs to be reachable by its children; the latter needs to reachable by pretty much everybody.

Why The Publication Protocol Is Useful

Motivation Overview Just because you want to hold your own private keys doesn't mean you want to be responsible for running a reliable 24x7 RPKI repository server. Somebody else might even want to sell that to you as a service, and you might want to buy it.

 Reducing the total number of places that relying parties need to go to collect all the RPKI content they need is probably better for everybody.

- Formerly one XML element type per known object type.
- Impossible (by design) to extend without revising protocol.
- On further analysis...that was a bad idea.
- So now we just have generic <publish/> and <withdraw/> operations.
