 - 100 test cases

What's new in the test suite

- Bug Fixes
- Prepared a website:
 - Implementers will be able to run the tests themselves
 - Not ready completely yet!
- General improvement of the previous tests and core logic

Interop results

- "Issues" in implementations have already been all seen before
 - Java Web framework bug
 - Dealing with invalid input data: 404 or 400 ?
 - Frameworks may generate the code before rdap server code kicks in
 - HTML answer instead of JSON for errors
 - Incomplete search implementations, or returning too many results

Implementations are converging => Good!

Questions raised

- How should a client interpret the answer from the server, how should it react to the various response codes?
 - Need a document for this ?
