At the OIF meeting held January 18-21, 2005, the OIF continued work in progress on an Implementation Agreement for *OIF Control Plane Logging and Auditing with Syslog*.

Attached for your information is the updated draft (oif2003.119) of the *OIF Control Plane Logging and Auditing with Syslog* implementation agreement, which specifies how to use syslog to log OIF Control Plane traffic as a basis for an auditing capability. It is based on RFC 3164, the syslog-sign draft, IPsec and syslog.conf.

We look forward to and encourage continued progress on the syslog-sign draft at the IETF. If the plans for this document, as listed in the current Syslog charter, are likely to change we would appreciate an update.
