19 **Subject: RoHC Revised Profiles Dependency**

21 Dear Thomas, Carsten and Lars-Erik,
22

23 The RoHC WG is currently working on revising the IP/UDP/RTP profiles defined in RFC 3095
24 to add support for reordering among other things. Reordering support in RoHC is extremely
25 important for 3GPP2, since packets can arrive out-of-order due to handoffs as well as ARQ
26 techniques at the physical and higher layers. Based on the RoHC WG charter, the WG is expected
27 to produce a couple of related documents – RoHC framework draft and Revised IP/UDP/RTP
28 profiles draft.

31 Both these documents are essential for 3GPP2. We would greatly appreciate it if you could
32 provide us the target completion dates of the above drafts. Also, we request that the work on these
33 documents be completed as soon as possible.
