A joint meeting of Q.9, 12 of SG 15 and Q.5 of SG 13 was held from the 22nd to the 27th of April in Kobe (Japan).

During that meeting, the comments received during the AAP Last Call on Y.1731 "OAM mechanisms for Ethernet based networks" have been considered and resolved by Q.5/13.

For your information, the latest version of draft Rec. Y.1731 that incorporates the agreed changes is here attached. During May, the document will be submitted to a final 3 week approval period (Additional Review), when ITU-T Member States and Sector Members will have the opportunity to make final comments on the content of the draft.

The next meeting of Q.5/13 will take place in Geneva, from the 16th to the 25th of July.
