The board agrees that assessing the environmental impact of IETF meetings is an important topic, but there is a lot of higher-priority work right now (e.g. hiring a permanent IETF ED). The board has added this topic to its work queue for 2020.

The IETF community and IESG should define more clearly what they need. The board will add some training line items to the 2020 budget just in case this is desired.
