Summary

- □ An option for specifying lifetime of other DHCPv6 options that have no associated lifetime
- □ Tells the client when to contact DHCP server to update configuration
- □Useful for planned changes, set small lifetime when change nears
- ☐ May be of help for unplanned changes, by using a small lifetime in unreliable environments
- □No server state required

Client behaviour

- □Client may include it in Option Request Option for all messages allowing ORO
- □ If client contacts server before lifetime expires, it should update data covered by option anyway
- □When expires, wait random time 0 INF_MAX_DELAY and try to update
 - OUsually Information-request Message.
- □ If this fails, behave as if lifetime option never received

Server behaviour

- □When sending options to client, server should use this option if:
 - ORequested by client
 - Or, if no options in message have associated lifetime
