- RESTCONF
  - CONTENT-TYPE HEADER
  - CAN USE ENCODING FORMATS AGREED HERE

# ISSUE#2

- SHOULD ENCODING INCLUDE MESSAGE LAYER?
  - SWITCH TO ENCODING AFTER <HELLO>
  - DO SO FOR MESSAGE AND YANG DATA

# ISSUE#1

- SUPPORT FOR NOTIFICATION
  - SWITCH TO NEW ENCODING AFTER <HELLO>
  - ALLOWS ALL NOTIFICATIONS TO USE NEW ENCODING

# ISSUE#3

- DO WE NEED <ACTIVATE> ENCODING
  - NO
  - SERVER SENDS UNORDERED LIST OF ENCODINGS
  - CLIENT SENDS ORDERED LIST OF ENCODINGS
  - THE FIRST MATCHING ENCODING IS PICKED

# ENCODING FORMATS

- SHOULD BE REGISTERED AS PART OF IETF REGISTRY
