IETF Administration LLC

- IETF LLC was legally created on August 27, 2018 & has assumed the IAOC's responsibilities
- Structure was defined by the IASA2.0 Working Group
- IETF Executive Director replaces the IAD position
 - Portia Wenz-Danley is the interim Executive Director
- IETF LLC Board of 5 Directors replaces the IAOC
 - 1 chosen by IESG, 1 chosen by ISOC Board of Trustees, 3 chosen by NOMCOM
 - NOMCOM selection is currently taking place & is seeking comments
 - Full board is expected to be seated by IETF104
 - Current interim board:
 - Glenn Deen – IAOC Chair (LLC Chair)
 - Alissa Cooper – IESG Chair
 - Ted Hardie – IAB Chair
 - Gonzalo Camarillo – ISOC BoT Chair

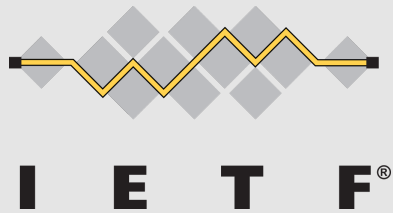
