IRTF Role & Scope:

The IRTF serves as the research arm of the IETF.

Organized under the auspices of the IAB.

Goals are to: (1) foster Internet-related research, and (2) develop preliminary technology needed for IETF efforts (includes responding to IETF needs).

Currently, 10+ RGs.

Generally long-lived, usually without specific deliverables.

Some operate closed, some open.

Closed ones maintain an open, public mailing list.
