### **PAA-EP Requirements**

#### Security

- PAA-EP protocol needs to guarantee identity, confidentiality and Integrity
- The protocol used between PAA and EP should be able to detect inactive peer within an appropriate time period and delete the related states.
  - Keep-alive between PAA<->EP
- The architecture needs to allow PaC and PAA initiated authentication
  - Event notification.
- Have a mechanism for a newly introduced EP to learn the policies currently in effect on that access network

Pull method

 PAA should be able to notify an EP for allowing/disallowing access for a particular client. This should happen without EP sending a request to the PAA.

– Push method












# PAA Co-located with EP but separated from AR






### **PAA co-located with EP and router**
