Who Has Read the TRIGTRAN Drafts?

- Draft-dawkins-trigtran-framework-00.txt
 - New draft, mostly what we've worked on since IETF 55
 - Mixed bag, but includes a strawperson framework
- Draft-dawkins-trigtran-probstmt-01.txt
 - Minimal update removing stuff we tossed at IETF 55
 - We do expect a full editing pass after chartering

Things To Remember

- TRIGTRAN isn't L2Triggers
 - RTT-ish latency requirements, not milliseconds
- TRIGTRAN trigger delivery not guaranteed
 - No notification ACKs
 - Partial deployment scenarios

Status Since IETF 55 in Atlanta

- We set out to write a Framework document
 - Strawperson in nature
 - Lots of questions about justification
 - Lots of questions about being doomed from the start
- We've learned a lot in the meanwhile
- We think we can do "Connectivity Restored"
 - End-to-end, as an implicit notification
- We think we need a framework to do anything else
 - Probably explicit notification, maybe edge-to-end
- Do we need to do anything else? Pls. advise

Current View of Strawperson Triggers

- We really like "Connectivity Restored"
 - "Kicking TCP" from Phil Karn on PILC list, March 2000
 - Requires small change to TCP - duplicate packets in RTO
 - Safe, deployable, useful
- "Connectivity Interrupted" *SHOULD* make sense
 - But seems to be very application-dependent
 - DoS bait unless it's neutered
 - "Wait longer or give up immediately"?
 - Could be engineered, but not ready for prime time
- "Packets Discarded" is actually "handoff" in GPRS
 - Would telling the transport really help? Slow start?
 - Less ready for prime time

One Proposed Statement of Work

Engineering?

- Spin up the working group, and ...
- Do "Connectivity Restored"
 - With an implicit trigger, end-to-end
 - Mobile host retransmit last packets on "link up"
 - Specify response for duplicate packets during RTO
 - Safe, good consensus, immediate benefit for users

?

- Investigate "Connectivity Interrupted" semantics
 - Transport might do something - but what?
 - Retry more times, or give up sooner - pick one!

Research?

- Investigate explicit mechanisms
 - Can we send out of band signals in the 2005 Internet?
- Build consensus on wish list for IRTF investigation
 - Horizontal handoff, non-congestion loss, corruption
 - Send wish list to Vern Paxson and ask for help

Issues from Framework draft

- We're presenting work we did
- "Connectivity Restored" needs little framework
- Other triggers aren't baked yet

Questions leading to a WG charter

- Does anything except "Connectivity Restored" make sense?
- Can our triggers be generated by existing subnetwork technologies?
- Can we agree on a list of reasonable responses?
- Is sending a wish list to the IRTF a Black Hole?
