Is it safe to use?
No? Old & Crufty - RFC required to describe dangers
Yes? Old & Crufty - No RFC required

w/ Approval by the IESG

#### What's out there?

draft-alvestrand-newtrk-historical-00.txt
 Committee considers a standard
 looks for usage
 considers safety
 makes recommendation to IESG
 IESG ratifies all decisions about standards
