# Reordering Robustness

---

DCR/NCR

Blanton/Allman/Dimond draft (charter item) on hold

- Blanton/Allman helping with DCR

DCR undergoing revision

- Renamed "NCR" (non-congestion response)
- Fleshing out specification
- Under-specified details
  - security issue
  - what to do when an extended Limited Transmit has nothing to send or cannot send (e.g., due to the advertised window)
  - concentrating on a dupack-based system rather than a timer-based scheme

Revision is progressing and should be out next week

# Revising 2581

---

## Two kinds of changes

- ☐ Bug fixes:
  - Collection of small fixes
  - Interested in outstanding issues
- ☐ Gathering "minor" changes into the document:
  - Only small items that have already attained RFC-hood
  - Larger initial window, Limited Transmit, Byte Counting
