

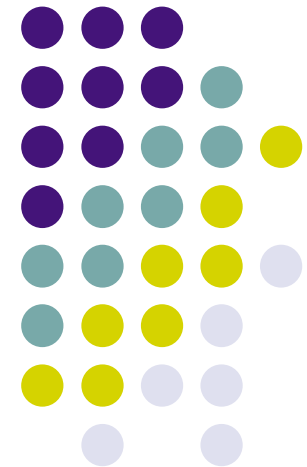

# Status summary



- How to use VLANs to deploy dual-stack IP networks with parallel IPv4/IPv6 routing infrastructures
  - In use in production in a number of (campus) sites, usually with IPv6-only BSD routers alongside 'legacy' IPv4 routers
  - But \*ONLY\* as an interim solution until dual-stack routing platforms are available for the enterprise
- Received many comments on -01 version
  - Modified -02 version proposed as WG item by WG chairs
  - Accepted earlier in 2005 but not yet resubmitted
