- Around 125 RFCs published (71 standard/BCP)
- 1 appeal

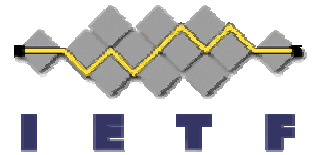
