What we have learned

- Unprecedented, coordinated action needed
- There will be architectural issues to address
- There will be working groups to form
 - and design teams and other non-WG groups
- More, continuing open discussion of issues needed
 - First step: clarity of problem statement
- We don't have time to mess around

What IAB & IESG Agree

- The IAB and IESG are taking this problem very seriously and will facilitate the process.
- This needs more input from other stakeholders
- We are considering
 - creation of group to help track the situation and the progress of the work
 - NOT to do the work or decide the solution
 - a series of additional IAB workshops
 - a non-WG forming BOF in Prague to review the work to that date

Immediate Question: How to best structure attention and coordination

- We need quick action
 - but this is not a sprint
- Have to balance
 - getting near-term, real progress
 - acknowledging this will be a multi-year effort
- We need to be able to continuously review and identify
 - engineering problems
 - architectural issues needing discussion
 - coordination discussions
