Description

- Message to request attention from a targeted user
- Feature known as poke, nudge or buzz in existing messaging platforms
- Standalone message or in the middle of a session
- Current draft allows the sender to indicate the preferred poke realization in the receiver side (vibration, light...)

Examples

Simple poke:

```
<?xml version="1.0" encoding="UTF-8"?>  
<poke xmlns="urn:ietf:params:xml:ns:im-poke"/>
```

“Rich” poke:

```
<?xml version="1.0" encoding="UTF-8"?>  
<poke xmlns="urn:ietf:params:xml:ns:im-poke"/>  
  <light duration="500" flashing="true"/>  
  <tone duration="500" frequency="660"/>  
</poke>
```
