# Changes since last meeting

- Fix remaining issue from MIB Doctor review
    - Make up an independent MIB module for selector functions
  - IPR Statement changed to trust200902
  - Alignment with IPFIX Configuration draft
    - Renamed ipfixSelectorTable to ipfixSelectionProcessTable
    - Introduced a new index ipfixSelectionProcessIndex
    - Addressed editorial improvements
- ⇒ Almost all issues addressed

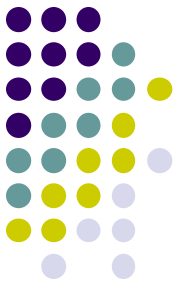
# Issues

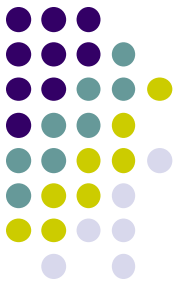


- Only minor and editorial issues open

# Next Step

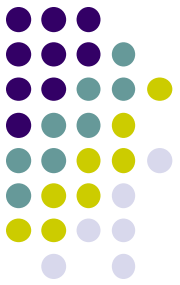
- We plan to post a new version this week
