## Listening to the Community +



- I E T F
- Minutes are being published & content has improved
  - 2009: All done
  - 2010: 5 Meetings to date
    - 3 published
    - 1 awaiting IAOC review
    - 1 under preparation
  - Feedback appreciated on minutes
- Scribe
  - Karen O'Donoghue volunteered
  - Still need additional scribes

## 2009 Financial Summary



- Entered 2009 with serious concern about economy and its effect on our finances
  - Planned for downturn with contingency budget
- ISOC provided \$150K stimulus funds that the IAOC used to lower registration fee
- ISOC set aside \$350K contingency fund to cover shortfall if needed

### 2009 Results



- Attendance stayed at planned levels | E T F<sup>®</sup>
- All meetings were fully sponsored
- Revenue was down from budget
  - Lowered registration fees to \$635
  - Day pass experiment
- Expenses were lower than budgeted
  - Lower food and beverage costs (~\$250K)
  - Use of new tools for conference calls (~\$75K)
- Net result was better than budget and we did not need any of ISOC extra commitment

  - Program Management

  - Transition from ISI to AMS completed
- RFC Publisher
  - Transition from ISI to AMS completed
- 109 RFCs published since 1 January 2010 !!!!

# RFC Series and Independent Submission Editor Status



- Transitional RSE selection completed and TRSE is under contract
  - Glenn Kowack
- Independent Series Editor selection completed and ISE is under contract
  - Nevil Brownlee
- ISI's contract extended into 2010 to provide for a smooth transition

## **Contract Cycles**

- Secretariat
  - Contract extended thru 2010
    - One year Extension or RFP in 2011
- RFC Editor Services Contracts
  - Contract with ISI extended through 30 June 2010 to assist with transition
  - New contracts in 2010 for Production Center and Publisher
    - Six year terms with 2 year reviews
- Independent Submissions Editor
  - 5 Year term with review at two year intervals with extension options
- Transitional RSE
  - Contract through IETF80
- NOC IDIQ Contracts with VeriLan and Swisscom thru 2011
  - Extension or new RFP in 2011 for next period

- Three Master Service Agreements executed for IDIQ Python-Django development
  - First task order to IOLA for IESG Data Tracker award soon
- Working Group and Author Requirement specification development

- Additional Task Orders and RFPs forthcoming

#### Notes

- 1 Registration fee was reduced from \$675 to \$635 after the Budget was approved.
- 2 No Large Interim Meetings were held. This had a net negative result to the budget, but would have been more severe if sponsors could not have been found for these meetings.
- 3 The Budget did not recognize in-kind NOC services provided by the host in Hiroshima.
- 4 New Revenue initiatives did not meet budget expectations.
- <sup>5</sup> Actual food/beverage, audio visual & other costs were below Budget for all three meetings.
- 6 Meeting space costs in Stockholm exceeded the Budget due to VAT taxes.
- 7 Actual costs were below Budget, including savings in telephones (\$104K); contract staff (\$50K); and travel and meeting expenses savings (\$54K)
- 8 Except for preparatory work, the Data tracker project **WAGE**a**Rel port**10.


