- It was decided to hold a face-to-face meeting in Beijing (so, here we are.)
- Before meeting, chairs to determine consensus for adopting documents pertaining to the three deliverables:
 - Problem statement and requirements document (Informational)
 - SIP call control UUI specification (Standards track)
 - ISDN UUI service application usage (Standards track)

Since interim meeting

- Call for adoption of the first deliverable (“Problem statement and requirements”) sent out to list on Oct-06-2010. Candidate draft: draft-johnston-cuss-sip-uui-reqs-00.
- Received a good number of favorable replies for adoption.
- Draft adopted as WG deliverable on Oct-24-2010.
- Author to rename as WG document and submit after the Beijing IETF.

Since interim meeting (contd.)

- After Beijing meeting is over, chairs will issue serial calls for adoption for the remaining two documents.
- Candidate drafts:
 - For charter deliverable “SIP call control UUI specification”, candidate draft is: draft-johnston-cuss-sip-uui.
 - For charter deliverable “ISDN UUI service application usage”, candidate draft is: draft-drage-cuss-sip-uui-isdn.
