# IETF-82 Preliminary Deadlines

- **Sept. 5th, 2011.** Cutoff date to notify the chairs/DISPATCH WG of plans to submit a proposal. [*Two weeks prior to BoF proposal deadline, 7 weeks before -00 deadline*]     **\*5 weeks from today\***
- **Sept. 12th, 2011.** Cutoff for charter proposals for topics. [Three weeks prior to BoF proposal deadline, two weeks before announcement of topics]
- **Sept. 26th, 2011.** Topics that are to be the focus of IETF-82 are announced. [10 days before AD BoF approval and deadline to request WG slot, 4 weeks before -00 deadline, deadline for requesting WG session]
- **October 24th, 2011.** -00 draft deadline.
- **October 31st, 2011.** Draft deadline.
