

Status

- No changes since last meeting
- All issues solved
- Submitted to for publication
- New issue came up:
 - IANA registration is not what we originally intended
 - Not well checked when IPFIX MIB (RFC 5815) was published
- IANA registered the whole IPFIX SELECTOR MIB
 - see http://www.iana.org/assignments/ianaipfixselector-mib (o)
- Intended was a registry for OIDs under object ipfixSelectorFunctions (1.3.6.1.2.1.194.1.1)
 - see, for example, http://www.iana.org/assignments/smi-numbers (o)
 - The IPFIX MIB registers already ipfixFuncSelectAll with index 1
 - The PSAMP MIB is going to register 6 further methods (indices 2-7)

Options



- 1. We can keep IANA registration as it is
 - will require changes to PSAMP MIB required
 - not what we really want
- 2. We can ask IANA to chage registration
 - stop maintaining the IPFIX SELECTOR MIB
 - create new OID registry for ipfixSelectorFunctions
 - will require changes to PSAMP MIB IANA section
 - will also require modifications of IPFIX SELECTOR MIB in RFC 5815
