

## **ITU-T Coordination Program**

- ITU-T is at a crossroads on how it deals with other organizations
  - Reviewing how it handles normative references
  - Reviewing how it liaises to other organizations, and how it accepts liaisons
  - IETF is part of this review
- Coordination meeting held in Taipei
  - Prepared for SG15 meeting in December
- SG15 / MPLS-TP OAM: Both G.8113.1 and G.8113.2 (IETF solution) not approved in December
  - Scott Mansfield, Sally Wentworth and a team led the effort
- TSAG: IETF / ITU-T MoU (RFC-3356 / Recommendation A Supplement 3) under review
  - IETF Liaison Manager to the ITU co-chaired ad hoc meeting in Geneva
  - Revision to take into account 9 years of updated procedures on both sides
  - IAB and TSAG have agreed on a process to update the document
- Program Offsite held 31 Jan 1 Feb
  - Continuing to evolve our long term view and goals for ITU-T relationship
  - Discussion on G.8113.1 and G.8113.2 next steps: ACH IANA code point required
  - Consistent messaging plan discussed
  - RFC-3356/A.supp3 next steps

# ITU-T Coordination Program (Cont'd)



- RFC-3356 Draft update to come out in April for review
  - Intended to continue to be an IAB document, as its predecessor was
  - Intended approval by the TSAG and IAB in July
- WTSA Preparations will continue
- SG17 meeting imminent
- SG15 MPLS-TP OAM
  - G.8113.2 will be discussed in September
  - G.8113.1 will be considered at WTSA in November
- IETF will participate, if invited, in ITU-T discussions about the Union's, and the T-Sector's continued evolution
