Generic Address Registration Procedure

- In networks that are centrally managed, self-generated addresses cause traceability issues due to their decentralized nature
 - There is consensus that self-generated addresses should be registered
 - There is consensus that DHCPv6 is a right protocol for the registration procedure
- There is argument on who should initiate the address registration requests
 - By host?
 - It is nature because it is who generates addresses
 - It is too much burden to ask on the hosts
 - Host may escape the address registration on purpose
 - By first hop router?
 - Allow both in the protocol specification?
