## If I could do it all over again ...

- 1.Don't use source code as a normative spec
- 2.Be clear about "optimized for internet"
- 3.Better plan for Liaisons with other SDOs particularly existing Joint \*
- 4. Sort out preferred IPR licensing terms early
- 5.Be clear about targets for coding efficiency
- 6.Decide if you are doing one codec or many
- 7. Have a strategy for achieving RF
- 8.Be clear if WG is creating new technology or selecting existing technology
- 9. Use signalling to have fine grain enablement of features
- 10. Have a clear idea how to get test results to inform WG decisions
