# **ITU-T Program**

- WTSA and WCIT are behind us. Key issues:
  - G.8113.1 (MPLS-TP OAM) codepoint is now assigned
  - G.8113.2 is approved (this is the IETF version)
  - Y.2770 (Y.dpireq) is approved
  - Strategic Review Committee formed to look at the long term structure of ITU-T (we should not participate)
  - A review relating to all collaboration will take place in TSAG
  - ITU-T is confused about what "normative" means in referencing. This will be addressed in TSAG
  - SG 11 will be handling Comformance & Interoperability testing
    - IPv6 is on the list in one question
    - SGs 13 and 17 have their eyes on LISP (but no experts)
  - Split within the Union over WCIT
- Program has now been scaled back
  - Focus of IETF should be on technical excellence
  - No robust response is required in the near future
    - Awaiting IESG choice for representation
- Program managers to transition
- Several outstanding liaisons (one to SG12 about to go out the door)
