Open Issue: Hold/Resume

Raised by Andy on List:

Section 3.3 of draft-ram-siprec-call-flows gives an example of a hold/ resume on the CS and how it is reflected on the RS and it shows the SDP in the RS being set to a=inactive for a participant.

This does not seem to be consistent with draft-ietf-siprec-protocol which in section 7.1.1.1 states:

"Note that when a CS stream is muted/unmuted, this information is conveyed in the metadata by the SRC. The SRC SHOULD NOT modify the media stream with a=inactive for mute since this operation is reserved for pausing the RS media."
