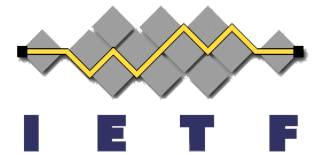


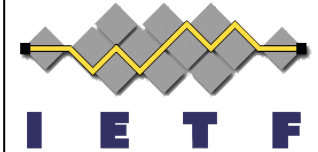

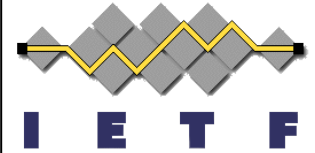

- A participant in any IETF activity acknowledges that written, audio and video records of meetings may be made and may be available to the public.

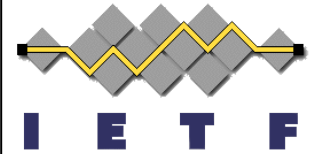
Intellectual Property

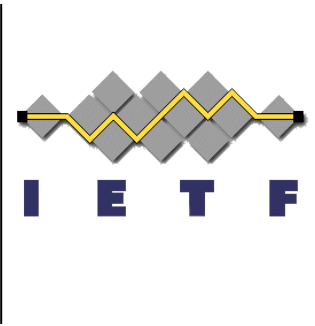


- When starting a presentation you **MUST** say if:

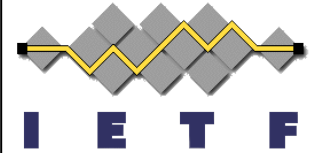

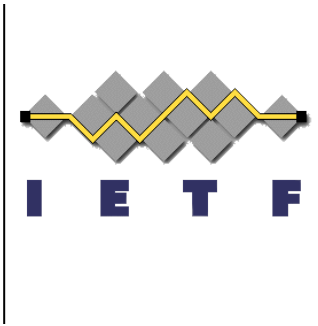

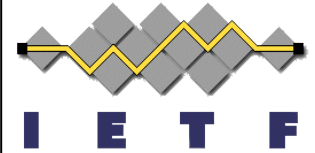

WG Status Update

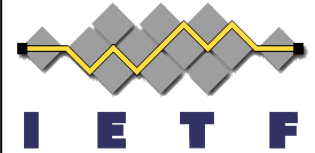
- draft-ietf-p2psip-base is in AUTH48

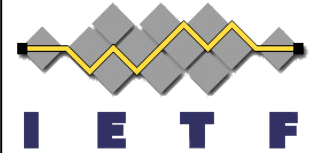
- Documents in WG process (cont'd)
