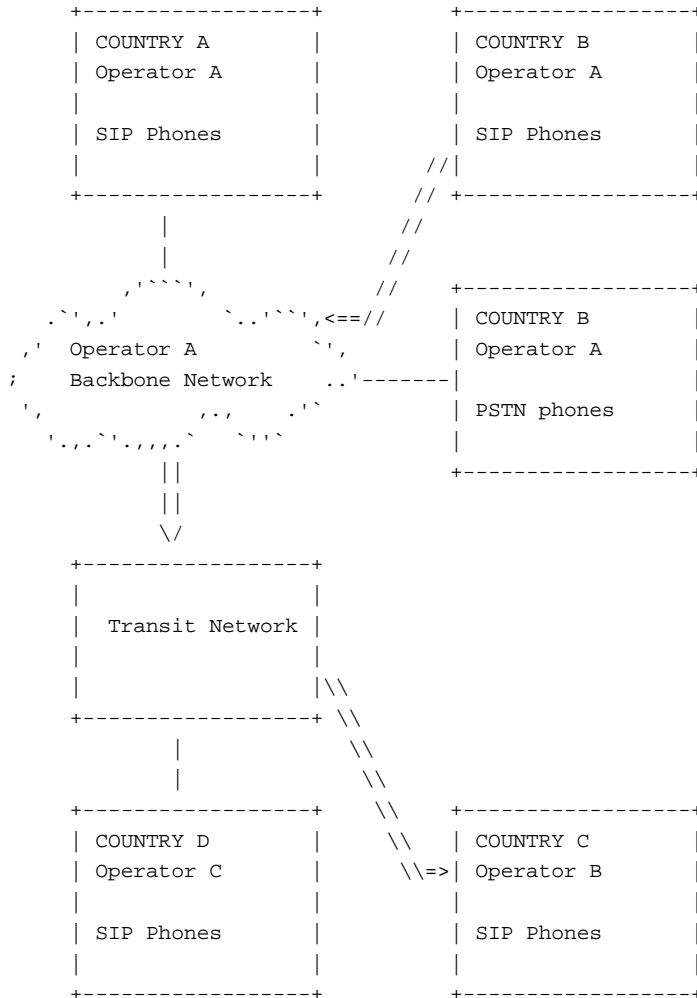


Marking SIP Messages to be Logged - Requirements

IETF#89 London

Problem Description



Signalling for SIP session setup can cross several networks

Networks may not have common ownership and also may be in different countries.

Not practical to pre-configure logging of an end-to-end SIP signalling of a session of interest. Not practical to log all signalling

Status of Requirements Draft

At IETF#88 Vancouver

(<http://www.ietf.org/proceedings/88/minutes/minutes-88-insipid>), call for consensus of adopting requirements one through eight

- consensus reached to adopt.
- does not include REQ9 regarding a logging server address and related sub-clause 6.2.2.
- also, clause 7 on potential solutions removed.
