 - draft-ietf-l3vpn-mvpn-mib / draft-ietf-l3vpn-l2l3-vpn-mcast-mib


Global Table Multicast

- Status on Global Table Multicast proposals
- Two drafts had been proposed since Orlando, presented whether in mboned or l3vpn, or both
 - draft-wang-mboned-glo-ipv6-mcast-reachability
 - draft-zzhang-l3vpn-mvpn-global-table-mcast
- draft-zzhang-l3vpn-mvpn-global-table-mcast was finally agreed to be the right solution
- Was presented to mboned today
- Chairs agree that l3vpn is the right home
- Will be called for adoption in l3vpn soon, with a heads-up to offer the opportunity for the mboned WG to comment
