- Reordered some use cases to improve the flow.
- Added use case on "Vehicular Networks".
- Shortened the Military Operations use case.
- Improved the security considerations section.
- Open issues:
  - <u>Section 3.11</u> should be replaced by a different use case motivating similar requirements or perhaps deleted if the IETF prefers to not work on specific requirements coming from military use cases.
  - <u>Section 3.8</u> and <u>Section 3.9</u> could be merged.
