How we got here



- Nomcom fills slots IESG tells them to fill
 - Nomcoms struggle to find TSV ADs
 - TSV had an AD w/out TSV experience
 - Spencer selected four months late
- TSV needs good ADs
 - Working group management
 - Document review
 - Area management
 - (Other duties as they arise)

What we asked at IETF 88 TSVAREA I E T F

- What makes you unwilling/unable to serve?
 - Time commitment?
 - Travel commitment?
 - Review commitment?
 - Management commitment?
 - Something else?
- Would ANYTHING make a difference?
- And the only answer we got was "time"

We've changed a few things



- IESG-level changes after Dublin retreat
 - More shepherd involvement
 - Include shepherds on telechats
- TSV-level changes in 2013
 - Recruited a TSVAREA secretary
 - We're planning to start a TSV-ART
- But we're still not far from 50 percent
 - Having 1-term TSV ADs doesn't help!
 - "100 percent commitment in first term"
