

Safety mode

- Safety mode hides videos that may contain inappropriate content flagged by users and other signals. No filter is 100% accurate, but it helps reduce inappropriate content.
- Safety mode also enables Google SafeSearch, and turning it off will disable Google SafeSearch.

The “safe” HTTP Preference

- One (and only one) bit
- “Safe” is explicitly defined by the site
- Complimentary to client-side / proxy filtering

The “safe” HTTP Preference

- **Not** the “child-at-keyboard” bit
- **Not** DNT
- **Not** a legal definition
