  - -- Better describe how this extension can be useful
  - -- Align with RFC2119
  - -- Discuss if/how clients can be made aware of this extension's added information
  - -- Add security considerations around more info than input for both valid and invalid addresses
  - -- Acknowledged the need for extension point RelaxNG/detailed xml and examples
  - -- Reworked terminology to better align with text
  - -- General editorial cleanup
