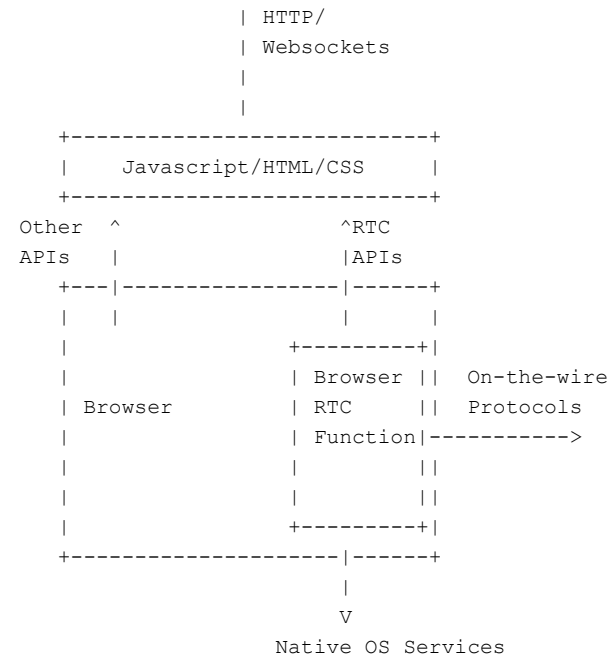
Status as of June 22 2014

Changes since Feb 14

- Abstract: Called it an Applicability Statement
- Body: Used MUST language for documents it depends on
- Terminology: Introduced “WebRTC browser” and “WebRTC device”
- Linked to current drafts; no longer -unified-plan, -cbran-codec or -generic-idp

Browser vs Device

- Browsers must have W3C-spec Javascript APIs
- Devices don't need to
- On-the-wire protocols are identical
- Need for control is identical
- Security reqs identical
