#### ■ Reminder


- L3VPN is closed, L2VPN will soon be closed too

  - → if adoption, will be resubmitted as draft-ietf-bess-...-00




# IPR disclosures

# Yang datamodels for BESS

- Yang work for BESS is relevant
  - Explicitly called out in our charter
- However...
- We think work needs to be done together with people from more than one vendor, and include operator(s)
  - We are unlikely to adopt drafts that fail to do that
- And coordination over the whole Routing Area is very important
  - People working on Yang datamodel proposals need to coordinate with other work in Routing area
