HIGH-RISK

ICANN considers that the Study presents sufficient evidence to classify *home* and *corp* as high-risk strings.

Given the risk level presented by these strings, ICANN proposes not to delegate either one...

Who is Doing This?

- Belief is that it's home network devices
 - e.g., BT Voyager home gateway answers to the name "voyager.home" (better than typing an IPv4 or IPv6 literal)
- Want to document and guide this usage
 - See draft-cheshire-homenet-dot-home
 - Send feedback if you see errors or omissions
 - We may discover that .home meets the needs of HOMENET and/or DNSSD
