WG status by Chairs

draft-ietf-clue-framework-22 went to the IESG and there are open comments from the AD, the crucial one is about the security section. It was indicated that more text is needed regarding user authentication. SIP in general allows unauthenticated users to establish sessions, but CLUE sessions may reveal information that one may not want to share with unauthenticated users. It was suggested to mandate authentication for CLUE sessions. ACTION POINT: Roni Even will send an e-mail to the mailing list, verifying the approach together with suggested text.

An XML Schema for the CLUE data model in draft-ietfclue-data-model-schema-10, the -10 draft was submitted after the WGLC. An Open issue – do we need an IANA registry for the policy token? Go to the list.

draft-ietf-clue-datachannel-09 is ready for publication but has dependencies on documents from other WGs. Need to reference the correct documents regarding how to secure a data channel.
