... where "stale" == "poorly aligned with the security model of the web"

- secure vs. non-secure is ad-hoc
- ignore port number
- subdomains
- depend on public-suffix list

let's get fresh

Problem	Proposal
Cookie slinging attacks	Secure (from http:)
Leakage	\$SECURE-, \$HOST-
Cookies don't align with origins	Origin-Cookie
CSRF	First-Party-Only

the choice is yours
