- RESTCONF, YANG Patch and YANG Library are through WGLC.
 - RESTCONF: Issues raised on the mailing list need to be addressed.
 - YANG Patch and YANG Library publication process has been started. Currently in AD review.
- Server Model: 2 open issues, key chain got a good review from SEC people. Proposal to split the draft into multiple parts.
- Zerotouch: 1 open, and 2 in review
- RESTCONF collection did not have progress
- NETCONF YANG Push started as WG item. RESTCONF YANG Push is being presented in this meeting. Draft organization will be discussed in this meeting.
