Charter Update:

- Completed the re-charter
- Posted the milestones
- Split into requirement milestones and solution milestones

Linda> There will be many NVE-NVA drafts, do you think all should be submitted by the milestone indicated?

Benson> These milestones are not meant to be prescriptive. May not happen by the time indicated but use as a guideline.

Erik> Regd requirements, is there enough energy to finish?

Benson> According to the charter, these (requirements) are optional.

Erik> You want to use this to pick a solution? If the goal is to help choose a solution, as requirements is a non-trivial exercise.

Benson> Would like you and others to critique on the mailing list. Charter specifies one control plane, but we do have wiggle room for others.

Tom H> Will solutions be considered now?

Benson> Encourage to have solution related documents submitted

Behcet – VM Mobility protocol

- There are some terminology issues in the draft and presentation. So, please ignore them for now
- There is some disconnect between 7364 and 7365
- If VM gets new address, use registrations to NVE or VM manager.
- If address do not change, use host routes and use BGP to optimize the updates.

Tom H> If VM gets new address mean, does it mean it will translate to new address?

Thomas > This WG never contemplated VM changing its address

Behcet> Explaining pros and cons of each type

Bhumip > We could articulate in the draft

- When VM with one subnet address to another subnet, then it is topologically incorrect
- VM with register with D-NVE

Another mechanism is to use Tunnels but adds overhead

Behcet – Is this something the WG should work on?

Pat> I thought it was implicit and we tunneling to let the NVE know where the node is. Already settled on tunnel based solution.

Benson> Take it to the list.

Linda: TS Migration

- This draft added solution from Rahul Agarwal draft.
- Here we are advocating NVA to administer locally administered VLAN ID's
- Two solutions, NVA based and E-VPN based.
- For details, please look into draft
- Optimal routing has two solution proposed.

Bhumip> In terms of implementations, does option 1 and 2 been implemented Linda> Both were implemented. NVGRE implementations use proxy based model.

Alia> In NVo3 we are not talking about BGP based solutions.

Linda> We just explained it, is that ok?

Alia> No

Benson> If you want to develop a solution, only NVA based solution is to be in NVo3. E-VPN should be in BESS WG

- L3 migration, main issue is IP optimal routing
- Host routing and Designated NVE's are two solutions
- There are some issues when encryption is used

Tom H> With triangular routing, it is not optimal

Erik> Are you assuming NVE3 do L3 for host routing?

Linda> Yes

Tom H> Should quantify which solution could be used where

- Had good discussion on mailing list.
- Would like to call for WG adoption

Benson> We should take it to mailing list.

Benson> Need to explore more on triangular routing. Could talk at Honolulu and see how to take it forward.

Linda: NVA mapping distribution mechanism

- NVA to NVE's could be connected in many ways
- NVA could be hosted on a separate server or embedded on a NVE.

Bhumip> Have we decided to focus on logically centralized NVA?

Benson> Charter says Logically centralized NVA.

Tom H> You mention VNID bitmap, doesn't it make a large bitmap? The virtual networks ID may not be sequential.

Linda> We could take the details to mailing list

Tom H> How frequent is it?

Linda> There are more ways. One way is to request at the re-start, to request all the VN ID's. Later on it could be incremental.

- As this is first version and received lots of suggestions, will take it to mailing list.
